Updates on EMC Projects & Homework:

- Pharmaceutical Take-Back Program: The Dutchess County Resource Recovery Agency (RRA) will be having a take-back program in the near future. The group discussed the state of recycling and waste disposal in the County. A report on the RRA and waste handling in the County is expected to be released on April 14, 2011. It will provide much-needed information recycling and waste disposal. The EMC offered to provide educational materials on recycling, proper disposal of pharmaceuticals, composting, etc. for the RRA if needed. EMC members will present the recycling capabilities of each member's town at the April 27, 2011 EMC meeting. Operation Pill Purge will take place in Fishkill May 21, 9-11 a.m. at the Firehouse and in Poughkeepsie on June 4, 9-11 a.m. at 37 Vassar Rd (the firehouse)
- Road Salt: Vicky Kelly will contact John Wagner of LaGrange to try to get on the May
 agenda of the Dutchess County Mayors & Supervisors Association to discuss the Road Salt
 Report and ways municipalities can reduce salt use while still maintaining ice-free roads.
 Pete Berasi will try to provide winter 2010-2011 salt-use data from East Fishkill to illustrate
 the salt and monetary savings from implementing salt-reduction steps.

 - 2. State of the Environment Report (Vicky Kelly to lead)

 - 4. Production of Educational Material for the NRI (John DeGilio & Maribel Pregnall)
 - 5. Energy Alternatives and Renewable Energy
